On February 18, 2011, Plaintiff's attorney filed a declaration in which he indicated that he was unable to file the motion for approval of the minors' compromise at this time due to the need to negotiate lien reductions with the Department of Health Services. (Doc. 42) Counsel believes that the motion may be filed by February 25, 2011. To ensure sufficient time for the negotiation and the preparation of the motion, the Court **GRANTS** the request for the extension of time. Therefore, no later than March 4, 2011, Plaintiff, Blanca Leon, is **ORDERED** to file a motion for approval of the minors' compromise according to Local Rule 202(b).

Failure to comply with this order may be grounds for the imposition of sanctions on counsel or parties who contributed to violation of this order. See Local Rule 160 and Local Rule 272.
