In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 73-305, this court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.

1                   Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

2                   1. The Findings and Recommendations issued by the Magistrate Judge on August  
3 28, 2009, are adopted in full; and

4                   2. Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment medical, malicious prosecution, conspiracy,  
5 equal protection and due process claims are dismissed. Defendants Tuhin, Cruz, Breckner,  
6 Ocampo, Hancock, Grewal, Dill, Chen, Ashby, Vasquez, Lopez, Hedgpeth and Molano are  
7 dismissed.
