15	Plaintiff Michael Eugene Hollis ("Plai	ntiff") is a federal prisoner proceeding pro se and in
16	forma pauperis in this civil action pursuant t	to and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action
17	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On April 27,	2012, the United States Marshal filed a request for
18	reimbursement for the cost of effecting persona	al service on Defendant Calvert. On May 3, 2012, an

19 order issued providing Defendant Calvert with the opportunity to show good cause for his failure to 20 waive service. On May 14, 2012, Defendant Calvert filed a statement of non-opposition to the 21 imposition of costs.

22 Rule 4 provides that "[a]n individual, corporation, or association that is subject to service under Rule 4(e), (f), or (h) has a duty to avoid unnecessary expenses of serving the summons." Fed. 23 24 R. Civ. P. 4(d)(1). "If a defendant located within the United States fails, without good cause, to sign 25 and return a waiver requested by a plaintiff located within the United States, the court must impose on the defendant . . . the expenses later incurred in making service" Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(d)(2)(A). 26

27 Defendant Calvert was given the opportunity to show good cause for failing to waive service 28 as required by Rule 4(d)(1) and Defendant Calvert does not oppose the imposition of costs.

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1	Defendant has not shown good cause for failing to waive service. The costs incurred by the Marshal		
2	in effecting service shall therefore be imposed on Defendant.		
3	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
4	1.	Within twenty (20) days from the date of this order, Defendant Calvert shall	
5		pay to the United States Marshal the sum of \$55.51;	
6	2.	The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the U.S.	
7		Marshal, Sacramento, California; and	
8	3.	The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on Defendant	
9		Calvert.
