3		summonses, a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction sheet and a
4		copy of the first amended complaint filed September 2, 2009.
5	3.	Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Plaintiff shall complete the
6		attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the completed Notice to the
7	Court with the following documents:	
8		a. Completed summons;
9		b. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed above; and
10		c. Three copies of the endorsed first amended complaint filed September 2,
11		2009.
12	4.	Plaintiff need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request waiver of
13		service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the Court will direct the
14		United States Marshal to serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule
15		of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
16	5.	The failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action
17		be dismissed.
