The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 18 302. 19 20 On December 15, 2009, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations 21 herein which was served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objection to 22 the Findings and Recommendations was to be filed within thirty days. Plaintiff did not file an 23 Objection to the Findings and Recommendations. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a 25 de novo review of this case.
