complaint, filed February 12, 2009, against Defendants Moonga and Akanno for deliberate indifference to Plaintiff's serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment. Trial is set for March 3, 2014.

Due to transportation issues related to movement of plaintiff Sammy Zamaro, the hearing on the motions in limine is CONTINUED to the date of trial, March 3, 2014 at 8:30 a.m. in Department 8.
