18	Plaintiff Sammy Zamaro ("Plaintiff"), a state prisoner, proceeded pro se and in forma pauperis	
19	in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action concerned Plaintiff's complaint,	
20	filed February 12, 2009, against Defendants Moonga and Akanno for deliberate indifference to	
21	Plaintiff's serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment. Trial began on March 3,	
22	2014, and concluded with a verdict in favor of Defendants Moonga and Akanno on March 4, 2014.	
23	(ECF No. 141.) Thereafter, judgment was entered in favor of Defendants Moonga and Akanno on
