15	Plaintiff Sammy Zamaro, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this		
16	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on February 12, 2009. On February 1, 2010,		
17	Plaintiff filed a motion requesting an order forcing the parties to participate in mediation. (Doc. 26.)		
18	Plaintiff erroneously reads Local Rule 270 ¹ as requiring that an order for mediation issue upon		
19	motion by a party. (Doc. 26, Med. Mot., p. 2.) However, before a case will be ordered to mediation,		
20	both parties must notify the Court as to the applicability of mediation. While Plaintiff has indicated		
21	a willingness to proceed to mediation, Defendants have not. If Defendants feel that mediation would		
22	be beneficial, they need to advise the Court– at which time the Court will ascertain its feasibility.		
23	Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion for o	rder that the parties participate in mediation, filed
