Plaintiff Sammy Zamaro (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action is proceeding on the complaint, filed February 19, 2009, against Defendants Moonga, Akanno, and Martinez for deliberate indifference to serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment.¹ Following Plaintiff’s motion for entry of default against Defendant Martinez, Defendant Martinez filed a notice regarding service on January 12, 2012, and an answer to the complaint on January 31, 2012. (ECF Nos. 71, 73.) Plaintiff filed a motion on February 23, 2012, stating that he did not receive a copy of either the notice or answer filed by Defendant Martinez.² (ECF No. 75.)
