17	proceeding with a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241, and challenges	
18	the length of his detention.	
19	On June 3, 2009, Respondent filed a motion to dismiss the petition as moot because	
20	Petitioner was released from ICE custody pursuant to an Order of Supervision on June 2, 2009.	
21	(See Attachment A (DACS Custody Summary Inquiry), to Motion.)	
22	Because Petitioner has been released from custody on an order of supervision, and is not	
23	longer being detained, the instant petition challenging the length of his confinement is moot, and	
24	must be dismissed. Cf. Picrin-Peron v. Rison, 930 F.2d 773 (9th Cir. 1991) (habeas petition	
25	dismissed as moot because INS Director had	d released (paroled) alien petitioner).
