Plaintiff is proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in 16 this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action is proceeding against Defendants E. 17 Lascano and J. Hamlin for retaliation in violation of the First Amendment. Pending before the Court 18 is Defendants' motion to compel, filed September 6, 2012. ECF No. 53. As of the date of this order, 19 Plaintiff has failed to file a response to the motion. 20 It is HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff is to respond to Defendants' motion to compel 21 within **twenty-one days** from the date of service of this order.
