- 4 2. Plaintiff's Due Process, Eighth Amendment, First Amendment, Cell  
5 Search, and State Law Claims, as well as Defendants Matthew Cate and  
6 James Yates are dismissed; and
- 7 3. This action is referred to the Magistrate Judge.
