20	Plaintiff's fifth amended complaint against Defendants Wu, McGuinness, Enenmoh, Jeffreys, and	
21	Jimenez in their individual capacities for deliberate indifference to serious medical needs in	
22	violation of the Eighth Amendment. (ECF No. 195, 199.)	
23	On June 15, 2017, Defendant McGuinness filed an answer to the fifth amended complaint.	
24	(ECF No. 212.) On June 16, 2017, the Court issued a discovery and scheduling order setting	
25	forth discovery procedures and filing deadlines. (ECF No. 216.) On June 19, 2017, Defendants	
26	Enenmoh, Jimenez, and Wu filed their answer to the fifth amended complaint, (ECF No. 217),	
27	and Defendant Jeffreys filed a motion to dismiss, (ECF No. 218). The Court issued a second	
28	discovery and scheduling order on June 20, 2	017, which also set forth discovery procedures and
