On September 10, 2012, the Court 16 17 set a mandatory scheduling conference for February 20, 2013, at 10:00 a.m. before the undersigned. (ECF No. 38.) On January 24, 2013, Plaintiff and Defendants Bhatt, Diaz, Nguyen and Wu filed a 18 19 joint request to continue the mandatory scheduling conference due to Defendants' pending motion to dismiss.
