18	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with a civil rights action	
19	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On January 23, 2012, Defendant V. O'Brien filed a motion for summary	
20	judgment pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56. Although Plaintiff was previously advised	
21	of the requirements for filing an opposition to motions for summary judgment, (see Doc. 27,) Plaintiff	
22	has not filed an opposition to Defendants' motion in accordance with the Local Rules.	
23	Plaintiff is therefore reminded that Local Rule 230(1) provides, in part, that: "Failure of the	
24	responding party to file written opposition or to file a statement of no opposition [within twenty-one days	
25	after the date of service of a motion] may be deemed a waiver of any opposition to the granting of the	
26	motion " Local Rule 110 also provides that failure to comply with the Local Rules "may be grounds	
27	for imposition of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the inherent power of the	
28	Court" including, but not limited to, dismissal of the	e action.

1	Accordingly, good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, within 21 days of the date	
2	of this order, Plaintiff shall file an opposition to Defendant's motion for summary judgment filed January	
3	23, 2012 or shall file a notice of non-opposition to the motion. Plaintiff is cautioned that failure to file	
4	an opposition will be deemed as a statement of non opposition and may result in a recommendation that	
5	this action be dismissed pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b).
