17	Plaintiff Lamont Shepard is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action	
18	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.	
19	On March 24, 2017 a settlement conference was held in this matter before Magistrate Judge	
20	Stanley A. Boone, at which this case settled. (ECF No. 186.) On March 29, 2017, a joint stipulation	
21	for dismissal with prejudice was filed, (ECF No. 188), and on March 30, 2017, this case was closed,	
22	(ECF No. 189).	
23	On July 5, 2017, Plaintiff filed a motion for funds, stating that his sister received some, but not	
24	all, of the settlement amount agreed to, and seeking for the Court to intervene and order Defendants to	
25	fulfill the terms of the settlement agreement. (ECF No. 191.) The Court finds it appropriate to require	
26	a response to Plaintiff's motion. To the extent necessary to resolve any dispute involving the	
27	settlement reached in this matter, the dispute is referred to Magistrate Judge Stanley A. Boone.	
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1	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that Defendant Wise shall file a response to Plaintiff's	
2	motion for funds, filed on July 5, 2017 (ECF No. 191) within fourteen (14) days from the date of this	
3	order. Plaintiff's reply, if any, shall be filed within seven (7) days following service of a response.
