18	pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 4	2 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United	
19	States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
20	Plaintiff filed a Motion for Summary Judgment on February 3, 2012, and Defendants filed		
21	a Motion for Summary Judgment on February 8, 2012. ¹ On May 30, 2012, the Magistrate Judge		
22	filed a Findings and Recommendations herein which was served on the parties and which contained		
23	notice to the parties that any objections to the Findings and Recommendations were to be filed		
24	within thirty days. On June 11, 2012, Plaintiff filed an Objection which has been considered by the		
25	Court.
