Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

On July 2, 2009, Petitioner filed a motion for judicial notice of the case of “Briceno v. Scribner (9th Cir. 2/23/09, 07-55665) 09 C.D.O.S. 2093; 2009 WL 426303.” (Court Doc. 13, Motion, at 1.) Petitioner is advised that the Court need not take judicial notice of case law. If Petitioner would like the Court to consider a certain decision, it is sufficient to cite the decision in his traverse to Respondent’s answer, if filed.
