FAILURE TO PAY FILING FEE

13 Plaintiff William Langston Meador (“plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil  
14 rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On June 17, 2009, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), the court  
15 found plaintiff ineligible to proceed in forma pauperis and ordered plaintiff to pay the \$350.00 filing fee  
16 in full within thirty days. (Doc. 4.) On June 30, 2009, plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration of the  
17 court’s order, which was denied on July 6, 2009. (Docs. 5, 6.) On July 16, 2009, plaintiff appealed the  
18 court’s order to the Ninth Circuit, and the appeal was dismissed on January 8, 2010. (Docs. 7, 11.)

19 On May 11, 2010, the court issued another order requiring plaintiff to pay the filing fee within  
20 thirty days. (Doc. 12.) On May 7, 2010, plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration of the court's order,  
21 which was denied on May 11, 2010. (Docs. 13, 14.) The thirty day time period for plaintiff to pay the  
22 filing fee has expired, and plaintiff has not complied with the court's order.

23 Accordingly, this action is hereby dismissed, without prejudice, based on plaintiff's failure to  
24 obey the court's order to pay the \$350.00 filing fee. The Clerk is directed to close this case in its  
25 entirety.
