16 Plaintiff Jerry Pollard ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 17 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On September 7, 2010, 18 the Court granted Plaintiff's motion to amend and ordered Plaintiff to file a second 19 amended complaint by November 1, 2010. (ECF No. 27.) To date, Plaintiff has failed to 20 file an amended complaint. The Court notes that Plaintiff was given leave to amend on his 21 own motion; the Court did not dismiss the prior complaint. In fact, the Court has yet to 22 screen Plaintiff's June 4, 2010 First Amended Complaint. Thus, Plaintiff has the option of 23 proceeding on his First Amended Complaint rather than filing a second amended 24 complaint. However, if he chooses to do so, he must inform the Court.

Accordingly, by **December 27, 2010,** Plaintiff must either file a second amended complaint or indicate that he wants the Court to proceed on his First Amended Complaint. ////
