

1	should not be dismissed for failure to appear at the mandatory scheduling conference, failure to file a
2	scheduling conference statement and failure to serve the complaint. Plaintiffs may comply with this
3	order by filing proofs of service indicating that the complaint and summons were properly served on
4	Defendants. Plaintiffs are advised of Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4, which specifies the proper
5	methods for service of a summons and complaint.
6	Plaintiffs are ORDERED to file a response, or properly executed return of service forms,
7	within sixty (60) days of the date of service of this order. Failure to do so will result in a
8	recommendation that this action be dismissed for failure to follow the Court's orders.
