15 This is a civil rights action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 by Plaintiff Floyd Scott, a
16 state prisoner proceeding pro se. This case shall be referred to United States Magistrate Judge
17 Jennifer L. Thurston to conduct a settlement conference.

18 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 19 1. This case is set for a settlement conference before Magistrate Judge Jennifer L.
20 Thurston on April 20, 2012, at 12:00 p.m. at California State Prison-Lancaster
21 (LAC), 44750 60th Street West, Lancaster, California 93536.
- 22 2. The parties shall appear at the settlement conference with full authority to
23 negotiate and settle the case on any terms.
- 24 3. Each party shall provide a confidential settlement conference statement to Sujean
25 Park, ADR Coordinator, 501 I Street, Suite 4-200, Sacramento, California 95814,
26 **no later than April 13, 2012**, and file a Notice of Submission of Confidential

1 Settlement Conference Statement (See L.R. 270(d)). Confidential settlement
2 statements **should not be filed** with the Clerk of the Court nor served on any
3 other party, and they shall be clearly marked “CONFIDENTIAL” with the date
4 and time of the settlement conference indicated prominently thereon. The
5 confidential settlement statement shall be **no longer than five pages** in length,
6 typed or neatly printed, and include the following:

- 7 a. A brief statement of the facts of the case.
- 8 b. A brief statement of the claims and defenses, e.g., statutory or other
9 grounds upon which the claims are founded; a forthright evaluation of the
10 parties likelihood of prevailing on the claims and defenses; and a
11 description of the major issues in dispute.
- 12 c. A summary of the proceedings to date.
- 13 d. An estimate of the cost and time to be expended for further discovery,
14 pretrial, and trial.
- 15 e. The relief sought.
- 16 f. The party’s position on settlement, including present demands and offers
17 and a history of past settlement discussions, offers, and demands.
- 18 g. A brief statement of each party’s expectations and goals for the settlement
19 conference.

- 20 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Litigation
21 Office at LAC at (661) 729-6994.
