20	On August 4, 2009, Ulices Mendoza Guizar filed a petition pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in	
21	case number 1:08-cr-00225-LJO. Plaintiff's petition was denied by the Honorable Lawrence J.	
22	O'Neill on August 4, 2009, and pursuant to Judge O'Neill's order, this civil rights action was opened	
23	in light of Plaintiff's contention that his medical needs are not being met, which may give rise to a	
24	viable claim for violation of the Eighth Amendment of the United States Constitution.	
25	Upon review, the Court finds that Plaintiff failed to sign his petition, construed as a	
26	complaint in this action. Therefore, it shall be stricken from the record and Plaintiff shall file a	
27	signed complaint within thirty days. Fed. R. Civ. P. 11(a); Local Rule 7-131.

1 To proceed with this civil rights action, Plaintiff must either pay the \$350.00 filing fee in full 2 or file an application to proceed in forma pauperis. 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a).
