**ORDER GRANTING STIPULATION
TO STAY LITIGATION AS TO
DEFENDANT R&D MEDIA NORTH
AMERICA B.V. d/b/a GLOMOBI
PENDING FINAL APPROVAL OF
CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT**

1 The Court, having considered the Parties' Stipulation to Stay this Action ("Stipulation to
2 Stay") filed April 23, 2010, hereby ORDERS as follows:

3 1. There is good cause to grant the Parties' Stipulation to Stay this action for a period
4 of ninety-one (91) days, and therefore, the request is hereby GRANTED;

5 2. This action, including the obligation to file any responsive pleadings, engage in
6 discovery, or respond to any pending motion, is hereby STAYED for a period of ninety-one (91)
7 days, through and including July 23, 2010.

8 3. The hearing on Plaintiffs' motion to remand currently set for May 14, 2010, at
9 9:30 a.m., is hereby VACATED;

10 4. The initial scheduling conference currently set for June 2, 2010, at 9:30 a.m., is
11 hereby VACATED;

12 5. The Parties shall file a Status Report **no later than July 19, 2010**, advising the
13 Court of the status of the proposed class action settlement in *Williams et al v. Motricity, Inc. et al*,
14 Case No. 2009 CH 19089, now pending before the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois; and

15 6. This Court SETS this matter for a Status Conference to be held **September 15,**
16 **2010, at 9:30 a.m.** in Courtroom 10 before Magistrate Judge Gary S. Austin. Related thereto, the
17 parties shall file a Status Conference Report **no later than September 8, 2010.**
