At the hearing, 21 a ruling on the motion for stay and abeyance was deferred until briefing could be 22 submitted on the motion for further equitable tolling. The Warden filed an 23 opposition to further equitable tolling December 7, 2011, and Doolin filed a reply January 3, 2012. 24 25 Doolin's motion for stay and abeyance and his motion for further equitable 26 tolling shall be submitted and resolved without additional oral argument from
