SECOND ORDER TO SUBMIT <u>SIGNED</u> APPLICATION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS OR PAY FILING FEE WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS

THIRTY DAY DEADLINE

Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant to 42 10 11 U.S.C. § 1983. On August 31, 2009, plaintiff submitted an **unsigned** application to proceed in forma pauperis. (Doc. 2.) On September 3, 2009, the court ordered plaintiff to submit a signed 12 application to proceed in forma pauperis, or pay the filing fee for this action, within thirty days. 13 (Doc. 4.) On September 25, 2009, plaintiff submitted another **unsigned** application. (Doc. 5.) 14 Each document submitted for filing must include the original signature of the filing party or 15 parties. Local Rule 7-131; F.R.C.P. 11(a). Plaintiff shall be granted another opportunity to 16 submit a **<u>signed</u>** application, or in the alternative, to pay the filing fee for this action. 17 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 18 Within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall re-submit the 19 20 enclosed application to proceed in forma pauperis, with plaintiff's original signature, or in the 21 alternative, pay the \$350.00 filing fee for this action. Failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be 22 23 dismissed. IT IS SO ORDERED. 24
