However, plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis only consists of 14 one page, and the second page, where plaintiff's signature would appear, was not submitted to 15 the court. Each document submitted for filing must include the original signature of the filing 16 party or parties. Local Rule 7-131; F.R.C.P. 11(a). 17 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 18 Within thirty (30) days of the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall re-submit the 19 20 enclosed application to proceed in forma pauperis, with plaintiff's original signature, or in the 21 alternative, pay the \$350.00 filing fee for this action.
