15 Plaintiff Raymond Ochoa, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis,  
16 filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on September 15, 2009. The  
17 action is proceeding on Plaintiff's original complaint against Defendant Dr. Jean-Pierre for  
18 acting with deliberate indifference to Plaintiff's medical needs in violation of the Eighth  
19 Amendment.

20 Plaintiff has filed a Motion for Appointment of Counsel. (ECF No. 16.) He states  
21 that he did not graduate from high school and fears that his limited education, coupled with  
22 his incarcerated status, will negatively impact his ability to litigate his claim. Upon review,  
23 the Court deems it appropriate to attempt to secure counsel for Plaintiff in this case. 28  
24 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1); Rand v. Rowland, 113 F.3d 1520, 1525 (9th Cir. 1997).
