Plaintiff Raymond Ochoa, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, his civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on September 15, 2009. On November 20, 2010, Plaintiff filed a Motion to Appoint Counsel. (ECF No. 16.) The Court found that the appointment of counsel was warranted and referred the case to the Eastern District's Pro Bono Coordinator to seek voluntary counsel to represent Plaintiff in this case.
