15	Plaintiff, Lamont Shepard, is a state prisoner proceeding prose and in forma pauperis in this				
16	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.				
17	Plaintiff has requested the appointment of counsel. The United States Supreme Court has				
18	ruled that district courts lack authority to require counsel to represent indigent prisoners in § 1983				
19	cases. Mallard v. United States District Court for the Southern District of Iowa, 490 U.S. 296, 298,				
20	109 S.Ct. 1814, 1816 (1989). In certain exceptional circumstances, the court may request the				
21	voluntary assistance of counsel pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1). Rand v. Rowland, 113 F.3d				
22	1520, 1525 (9th Cir. 1997). Without a reasonable method of securing and compensating counsel,				
23	this court will seek volunteer counsel only in the most serious and exceptional cases.				
24	In the present case, the court does not find the required exceptional circumstances. See Rand,				
25	113 F.3d at 1525. Even if it is assumed that plaintiff is not well versed in the law and that he has				
26	made serious allegations which, if proved, would entitle him to relief, his case is not exceptional.				
27	This court is faced with similar cases almost daily. Therefore, plaintiff's request for the appointment				
28	of counsel shall be denied.
