Fields ("Plaintiff") is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se and in 13 forma pauperis in this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on Plaintiff's 14 Eighth Amendment claim regarding unsanitary conditions in his cell against Defendants Hernandez, 15 Molina, Marsh, and Tucker, and on Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claim regarding inadequate 16 temperature in his cell against Defendants Hernandez, Molina, and Marsh. 17 Within twenty (20) days from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff and Defendants are 18 each to file a written response indicating whether a court settlement conference would be beneficial 19 20 in resolving this action.
