Such statements shall be limited to five (5) pages and shall include the following: 1) The party's assessment of whether the instant action is of the type that would benefit from a settlement proceeding; 2) The party's assessment of what factors, if any, will prevent settlement of this matter prior to trial; and 3) Any additional information the court may find useful in determining whether to set this matter for a settlement conference. Should the Court determine this action to be appropriate for referral to the Prisoner Settlement Program, the Court will set this matter for a settlement conference before a magistrate judge or district judge.
