This is an immigration case in which plaintiffs have filed to challenge U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services' (CIS) failure to timely adjudicate their naturalization applications and to seek de novo review of these applications. As of the time of this filing, the agency is prepared to adjudicate the applications. Because of the jurisdictional posture of the case, the agency cannot complete that process until the case is remanded with instructions to CIS. 8 U.S.C. § 1447(b). Accordingly, the parties jointly agree that the case should be remanded with instructions to complete adjudication of the case within 60 days from the date of the order of remand. In the event CIS fails to timely complete this adjudication, the parties agree that jurisdiction will revert to this Court, and a scheduling conference will take place as soon as possible.
