15	Plaintiff Cedric Greene is a former state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma
16	pauperis in this civil action. On November 3, 2010, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's
17	Complaint for failure to state a claim because it was barred by Heck v. Humphrey, 512 U.S.
18	477, 487(1994). Before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to Amend his Complaint
19	asking the Court to reconsider its dismissal and instead allow him to amend his complaint.
20	Plaintiff's Motion to Amend is DENIED. Judgment was entered in this case on
21	November 3, 2010, and the case is closed. Since Plaintiff's claims were dismissed without
22	prejudice, he is free to file a new action if he desires to pursue claims other than those
23	alleged in his prior Complaint.
