24 problematical. (Doc. 13). The Court notes that none of the Defendants has filed a responsive pleading  
25 in this matter and that the deadlines for each Defendant to do so have now elapsed. Accordingly, IT IS  
26 HEREBY ORDERED that:

27 1. The Scheduling Conference set for Monday, June 7, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. is vacated and  
28 reset for Monday, August 2, 2010 at 9:00 a.m at 1200 Truxton Avenue, Suite 120,

1 Bakersfield, CA before Magistrate Judge Jennifer L. Thurston;

2 2. The parties must file a Joint Scheduling Report no later than Monday, July 26, 2010;

3 3. Defendants must file a responsive pleading in this matter no later than June 28, 2010; and

4 4. If Defendants fail to respond by June 28, 2010, no later than July 7, 2010, Plaintiffs must

5 apply for entry of a default judgment.

6 The parties are admonished that strict adherence to these deadlines is required and that failure  
7 to comply will result in the imposition of sanctions pursuant to Local Rule 110.
