17	Plaintiff James Lee Helm is a civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this	
18	civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On January 8, 2010, Plaintiff filed a request for the	
19	Court to clarify his status as a civil detainee in this action. (Doc. 5.) Plaintiff objects to being	
20	referred to as a prisoner, given the finding in <u>Torrey</u> that civil detainees are not prisoners. <u>Page v.</u>	
21	Torry, 201 F.3d 1136, 1140 (9th Cir. 2000.) Plaintiff requests that the Court instruct the Clerk of	
22	Court and the defendants in this action not to refer to Plaintiff as a prisoner. In addition, Plaintiff	
23	requests that the case number for this action be changed to reflect a wholly civil case.	
24	The Court is aware that Plaintiff is a civil detainee and not a prisoner within the meaning of	
25	the Prison Litigation Reform Act. The 555 nature of suit designation for this action reflects a case	
26	filed by a civil detainee rather than a prisoner, and Plaintiff's case is being treated as such. Any	
27	inadvertent reference to Plaintiff as a prisoner should be disregarded. The assignment of Plaintiff's	
28	case number is nurely administrative in nature, ar	nd has no substantive effect on this case. The case

1	number was not assigned in error given how civil rights cases filed by prisoners and detainees are		
2	handled administratively, and it will not be changed.		
3	Based on the foregoing, Plaintiff's request for clarification is HEREBY DEEMED		
4	RESOLVED.
