15 Plaintiff Joshua Todd Woolridge, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis,  
16 filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on December 8, 2009. On July 9, 2010,  
17 the Court revoked Plaintiff's in forma pauperis status and ordered him to pay the \$350.00 filing fee  
18 within thirty days or this action would be dismissed. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).19 Plaintiff appealed the in forma pauperis revocation, but on September 21, 2010, his appeal  
20 was dismissed for failure to perfect the appeal and mandate was issued. Accordingly, pursuant to  
21 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), this action is HEREBY DISMISSED without prejudice to re-filing if  
22 accompanied by the \$350.00 filing fee.23
