The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate 17 Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 18 19 On April 28, 2011, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending that 20 this action proceed with the First Amended Complaint filed on December 6, 2010, on Plaintiff's 21 Eighth Amendment claims found cognizable by the Court against defendants C/O A. Fernando and 22 C/O M. Jericoff for use of excessive force and against defendant Warden James Yates for failure to 23 protect Plaintiff; and on Plaintiff's related state tort claims; and that all remaining claims and 24 defendants be dismissed, based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim. (Doc. 17.) Plaintiff was 25 provided an opportunity to file objections to the findings and recommendations within thirty days. To date, plaintiff has not filed objections or otherwise responded to the findings and 26 27 recommendations. 28 1
