24	Defendants filed objections to the findings and recommendations.

7	3. Defendants' motion for summary judgment is denied as to Plaintiff's Eighth	
8		
9	Amendment claims and state law claims against Defendants Jericoff and Fernando.	
10	4. The Court declines to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over Plaintiff's state law	
11	claim of negligent hiring.	
12	5. This action is referred to the Magistrate Judge for further pretrial proceedings.
