APPLICATION TO PROCEED IN FORMA 11 **PAUPERIS** 12 13 Plaintiff Joaquin Ramon Quiroz ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this 14 civil rights action. The deadline for submitting an application to proceed in forma pauperis was 15 March 29, 2010. As of the date of this order, Plaintiff has yet to pay the filing fee or submit a 16 motion to proceed in forma pauperis. On April 19, 2010, the Court ordered Plaintiff to show 17 cause as to why this action should not be dismissed for failure to obey a court order. On April 18 28, 2010, Plaintiff responded. Plaintiff states that he contacted the counselor, and on February 19 22, 2010, the counselor signed Plaintiff's IFP form, and placed it in a pre-paid envelope for 20 delivery to this Court. Plaintiff contends that he was unaware that the IFP form was not 21 delivered. Plaintiff requests a thirty-day extension of time to submit his IFP form. 22 Good cause having been shown, the Court HEREBY ORDERS that the order to show cause is DISCHARGED. Plaintiff is GRANTED thirty days from the date of service of this 23 24 order to file his application to proceed in forma pauperis.
