25	attached application to proceed in forma	pauperis, completed and signed, or, in the alternative, pay	
26	the \$350.00 filing fee for this action. No	requests for extension will be granted without a	
27	showing of good cause.		
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1	Failure to comply with this order will result in dismissal of this action.
