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15	Plaintiff Jose A. Vega is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action, which
16	was removed from Fresno County Superior Court on January 5, 2010, by Defendant J. Yates and F.
17	Igbinosa. 28 U.S.C. § 1441(b). On March 4, 2011, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for
18	failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended
19	complaint within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. On April 8, 2011, the Court granted Plaintiff a
20	sixty-day extension of time to file an amended complaint, but the time period has expired and
21	Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no
22	pleading on file which sets forth any claims upon which relief may be granted.
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1	Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A, this action is HEREBY DISMISSED, with
2	prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted.
