Pursuant to the mandate of the United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit, the 20 judgment of the District Court was vacated and this case was remanded for further factual 21 development of the record. On October 2, 2014, this Court ordered Respondent to file a brief 22 and any additional materials to further develop the record. On November 26, 2014, Respondent 23 filed his response and requested that the Court set a status conference hearing for the purpose of 24 25 authorizing formal discovery and setting a schedule therefor.
