Defendants' Motion to Enforce the Settlement Agreement is GRANTED; 3. 8 Defendants are ORDERED to make payment to Plaintiff as provided in the parties' 9 settlement agreement; 4. 10 Defendants are ORDERED to submit a statement establishing when and to whom the 11 settlement payment was made no later than May 29, 2013; and 12 5.
