20	showing of good cause. Within sixty (60) days of the date of service of this order, plaintiff shall
21	submit a certified copy of his prison trust statement for the six month period immediately preceding
22	the filing of the complaint.
23	Failure to comply with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be
24	dismissed.
