Petitioner is a prisoner proceeding pro se with a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

On November 23, 2010, judgment was entered denying the petition for writ of habeas corpus. On December 28, 2010, petitioner filed a notice of appeal, a motion for certificate of appealability. On January 11, 2011, petitioner filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis.
