Plaintiff Anthony Shorter (“Plaintiff”) is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action. Pending before the Court is Plaintiff’s motion for the return of his exhibits, filed March 2, 2011. Plaintiff has complied with the Court’s order and submitted a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of his documents. *Id.* Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court return Plaintiff’s first amended complaint and amended exhibit by mail.
