1 California's rules require the notice of motion and declaration to be served on the client  
2 and all other parties who have appeared in the case. CRC 3.1362(d). All parties have been  
3 served with the notice of motion to withdraw filed by Cypress, LLP.

4 **Defendant, James Kerr d/b/a West Coast Ammunition, is advised that failure to**  
5 **take appropriate legal action may result in serious legal consequences, and consideration of**  
6 **obtaining legal assistance is strongly advised.**

7 **In addition, a "corporation may appear in the federal courts only through licensed**  
8 **counsel." *Rowland v. California Men's Colony*, 506 U.S. 194, 202 (1993). *See also* Local**  
9 **Rule 183(a) (providing that a corporation or other entity may appear only by an attorney).**  
10 **A president or shareholder may not represent a corporation in court but must retain**  
11 **appropriate licensed counsel. *United States v. High Country Broadcasting Co., Inc.*, 3 F.3d**  
12 **1244, 1245 (9<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1993), *cert. denied*, 513 U.S. 826 (1994).**

13 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the Motion to Withdraw as Counsel for  
14 Defendant James Kerr d/b/a West Coast Ammunition, brought by attorneys Cypress, LLP, is  
15 GRANTED. Defendant, James Kerr d/b/a/ West Coast Ammunition, is hereby ORDERED to  
16 retain legal counsel within **thirty (30) days** from the date of service of this order.
