19	Consent or Request for Reassignment, requiring plaintiff to complete and return the form within	
20	thirty (30) days, indicating either his consent to the jurisdiction of the U.S. Magistrate Judge, or	
21	requesting that the case be reassigned to a U.S. District Judge. The second thirty (30)-day period	
22	has now expired, and plaintiff has not returned the form, or otherwise responded to the court's	
23	order.	
24	Local Rule 110 provides that "failure of counsel or of a party to comply with these	
25	Local Rules or with any order of the Court may be grounds for the imposition by the Court of any	
26	and all sanctions within the inherent power of the Court."	
27	Based on the foregoing, it is HEREBY ORDERED that within thirty (30) days	
28	from the date of service of this order, plaintiff s	shall complete and return the Order Re Consent or

1	Request for Reassignment, a copy of which is attached hereto, or show cause, in writing, why	
2	sanctions, up to and including dismissal of this action, should not be imposed against him for	
3	failing to obey a court order.
