23 This matter came before the Court on Plaintiffs General Electric Company and GE Wind
 24 Energy, LLC's (collectively "GE") *Ex Parte* Application for an Order Modifying the Hearing
 25 Date on Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Docket No. 23), Defendant Thomas
 26 Wilkins' ("Wilkins") Motion to Shorten Time on His Motion to Dismiss (Docket No. 27) and
 27 GE's July 27, 2010 request for a further scheduling order. The Court having read and considered
 28

1 the parties' papers and hearing counsel's argument at the July 22 and 28, 2010 scheduling
2 conferences hereby ORDERS that:

- 3 1. GE shall electronically file and serve its motion for a temporary restraining order
4 on July 26, 2010 before 12:00 p.m.
- 5 2. Wilkins' opposition to GE's motion for a temporary restraining order shall be
6 electronically filed and served before 5:00 p.m. on August 4, 2010.
- 7 3. No reply brief to be submitted.
- 8 4. The hearing on GE's motion for a temporary restraining order will take place on
9 August 6, 2010 at 12:00 p.m.
- 10 5. GE may take the deposition of Wilkins, and Wilkins may take the deposition of
11 GE's witnesses who filed declarations in support of GE's motion for preliminary
12 injunction. The depositions are to be limited scope depositions to address only the
13 issues in GE's motion. The parties have met and conferred and the depositions are
14 scheduled for:
 - 15 a. Thomas Wilkins: August 2, 2010 at Glynn & Finley, LLP's offices in Walnut
16 Creek, CA.
 - 17 b. GE's witnesses (James McGinness, David Hunt and Norland Brace): August
18 3, 2010 at Glynn & Finley, LLP's offices in Walnut Creek, CA.
- 19 6. The costs associated with the depositions of Mr. Wilkins and GE's witnesses,
20 including travel, hotel and related costs, and deposition transcript costs, are
21 recoverable pursuant to Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Rule 54(d) to the
22 prevailing party in this action.
- 23 7. The Court will set the hearing dates for GE's motion for preliminary injunction and
24 Wilkins' motion to dismiss after ruling on GE's motion for a temporary restraining
25 order.
